FOR SPANISH NATIONALS WITHOUT A VALID NATIONAL IDENTITY CARD LIVING ABROAD

To request your Consular Digital Certificate, follow these steps:

What is the NICC?

The NICC is your consular identification number. It is unique, permanent, and identifies you as a Spanish citizen abroad.

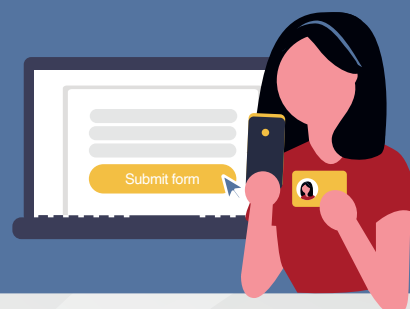

Complete the form with your passport, first surname, email address, and phone number (both with verification codes), and carry out the video accreditation.

Identity verification and NICC validation

You will be able to check the status of your NICC online using your personal data. If your NICC is not up to date, you can obtain it at the consulate where your birth is registered.

Download

Once your NICC has been validated, the consulate authorizes the issuance of the certificate. The FNMT-RCM generates it, and you can download it directly from their website.
